We are very proud that RAMPAGE has been one of the PREMIER tournaments in the state! This year's event will once again be at College of the Canyons in Valencia, CA. Cougar Stadium is a modern facility with a great viewing opportunity for spectators. The stadium has an excellent performance field with a million-dollar Field Turf and a full concession stand. In addition, when you make plans for your band to attend RAMPAGE, keep in mind that Six Flags Magic Mountain is only a few miles away from the stadium! We will be using SCSBOA caption judging, and will be providing both rating and competitive options. Panel will include one head judge, one music performance judges, one visual judge, one effect judge, one color guard judge and one percussion judge. **We will also be implementing new timing limits. 5 minutes minimum for traditional competition/11 min max or No minimum timing requirement for Ratings or Comments only.**

To reserve a spot in this year's RAMPAGE, return the enclosed application along with a non-refundable check of **\$350 on or before Friday, September 10**. Please be sure to follow the SCSBOA guidelines regarding Band Classification at the bottom of the application. The order of performance will be determined by the order in which applications and payment are received. The earlier you apply, the later you will perform in your respective divisions. - Band Directors may choose to compete in a larger band classification if they wish. Once this decision is made, the group will remain in that division for the entire season.
- A band may not move down a division.
- **Bands must remain the designated division determined by the formula above for the entire marching season.** The placement within a division will be determined by the group's enrollment at their first SCSBOA adjudicated event.
- If the number of performing members exceeds the classification numbers declared for that band, all units in the band will be assessed a five (5.0) point penalty.
- In situations where inclement weather or poor field conditions prohibits field performance, competitions may take place outdoors or inside gymnasiums at the discretion of the tournament host AND head judge. The entire judging panel will be used to adjudicate the music, general effect, auxiliary and percussion captions. Scores from these events will not count as qualifying scores for the SCSBOA Field Championships if held.
- Host bands may perform in their own tournament to secure a qualifying score for the SCSBOA Field Championships and are to be scheduled within their appropriate class. Scores earned will appear on the official recaps. Trophies need not be awarded.
- Bands must compete at two SCSBOA field events in 2021 to qualify for championships if held.
- This Field Tournament Entry/Classification Form must be sent to the Event Host and **NOT** the SCSBOA office. This is not the official SCSBOA Championships Entry Form. That is a separate entry form.
